

Notice on Dormitory Application and Registration for the Fall Semester 2026 (Current Students)

1. Eligibility

Undergraduate and graduate students currently enrolled at Yonsei University

※ Students in the College of Medicine (Pre-medical Program) and Nursing students in their second year or above should contact Wonui Hall (College of Medicine Dormitory) at +82-33-741-0217.

A. Applicants Ineligible for Dormitory Admission

- 1) Students who have received a dormitory eviction/suspension sanction within the past six months
- 2) Students with a GPA of 1.74 or below (on a 4.3 scale)
- 3) Students whose cumulative merit/demerit score is -10 points or lower
- 4) Students who have been subject to disciplinary action under university regulations
- 5) Students on a leave of absence (students scheduled to return from leave in Fall 2026 are eligible to apply)
- 6) Students deemed unsuitable for dormitory life

3. Application Period: July 13 (Mon), 2026, 14:00 – July 16 (Thu), 2026, 12:00

A. Application Procedure

(PC only / Mobile devices are not supported)

Access the Yonsei Portal (portal.yonsei.ac.kr) → Login → Academic Information System → Dormitory → Dormitory Application → Review the information and submit your application.

※ Your application is considered complete only after you click "Final Submit."

B. Dormitory Assignment

If the number of applicants exceeds the capacity of a dormitory hall, **applicants may be assigned to a different dormitory hall than the one requested or may not be selected.**

※ For undergraduate students admitted in 2026, all applicants will be accepted unless they fall under the ineligible categories. However, applicants may be reassigned to a different dormitory hall if the requested hall exceeds its capacity or if they apply for a hall for which they are not eligible.

C. RC Program Status

Students assigned to RC and Non-RC housing cannot request each other as roommates.

(**RC student + RC student: Roommate request permitted** / **RC student + Non-RC student: Roommate request not permitted**)

※ If you wish to request a Non-RC student as your roommate, **please do not select the RC option when applying.**

1. RC (Residential College): Students enrolled in a leadership course designated under the Residential College (RC) program.
2. Non-RC: All other students who are not participating in the RC program, including returning students, transfer students, and graduate students.

D. Selection Criteria

1) Merit and Demerit Points (Highest Priority)

- Evaluated based on the most recent semester in which the student resided in the dormitory.
- Definition of the most recent dormitory semester: The last semester during which the student lived in the dormitory.

Example: If a student lived in the dormitory in Spring 2024 and is applying again for Spring 2026, the merit and demerit point record from Spring 2024 will be used for evaluation.

2) Academic Performance

- Evaluated based on the semester immediately preceding admission.
- If applicants have the same merit point total, those with higher academic performance will be given priority.
- Definition of the semester immediately preceding admission: The most recent semester in which the student was enrolled, regardless of whether the student resided in the dormitory.

Example: If a student was enrolled through Fall 2024, took a leave of absence, and then returns in Fall 2026, the GPA from Fall 2024 will be used for evaluation.

4. Dormitory Fees and Facilities

※ Maeji Hall 3 is the only residence hall with 24-hour access, including for graduate students. Access to other residence halls is subject to curfew regulations.

* Maeji Hall 3 operates its four-person rooms as three-person rooms.

C. Common Facilities (Per Room): Bed, desk, wardrobe, shoe rack, and mini refrigerator

- 1) Beds, desks, wardrobes, and shoe racks are assigned individually. **Unauthorized use of unassigned spaces** may result in demerit points.
- 2) **Unauthorized occupancy of an unassigned room** will result in eviction from the dormitory.

D. Dormitory Student Council Fee

- 1) If students opt in to the Dormitory Student Council membership, KRW 4,000 will be added to the billing statement.
- 2) The fee is used for the purchase, maintenance, and repair of welfare facilities within the dormitory (e.g., microwave ovens, hot plates, vacuum cleaners, pianos, etc.), as well as for student welfare enhancement programs.
- 3) No refunds will be issued for students who withdraw from the dormitory mid-term.

A. Payment Policy

Failure to complete payment within the designated period will result in **automatic cancellation of admission**

without individual notification. (No additional payment period will be provided.)

A. Application Method

(PC only / Mobile not supported)

Yonsei Portal → Log in → Dormitory → Roommate Application

- RC and Non-RC students cannot request each other as roommates. (RC–RC roommates allowed; RC–Non-RC roommates not allowed.)
- If RC status is incorrectly selected, roommate pairing with Non-RC students will not be possible.

8. Check-in Information

A. Residence Period: August 28 (Fri), 2026, 15:00 – December 23 (Wed), 2026, 11:00 (117 nights)

B. Check-in Procedure

Visit the dormitory reception desk at the entrance → Submit required documents → Identity verification → Receive key card

※ **Required Document:** 1 copy of **tuberculosis test result (Chest X-ray examination)**

- 1) Only test results issued **after July 1 of the same year** are accepted.
- 2) Only chest X-ray results are accepted for tuberculosis screening.
- 3) Tuberculosis test results included in a health certificate or military medical examination report may also be submitted. (Submission of full health examination reports containing excessive personal information may be restricted.)

※ **All required documents must be submitted on the day of check-in. Failure to do so will result in restricted admission.**

C. Items for Move-in

1) Required Items: ID card, toiletries, clothing and bedding, LAN cable and wireless router

※ For parcels delivered before the move-in date, items will be stored in the lobby. The dormitory is not responsible for any loss of parcels.

※ Maeji Halls 1, 2, and 3 use wireless Wi-Fi only; personal routers are not required (wired internet is not available).

2) Prohibited Items: Hair irons, vacuum cleaners, all heating appliances, any electronic devices not explicitly permitted, personal furniture, pets, high-capacity batteries, and cryptocurrency mining devices

※ Any cryptocurrency mining devices found will result in immediate eviction and permanent restriction from dormitory admission.

3) Permitted Items: Hair dryers, USB-powered fans, USB-powered air purifiers, and non-heating USB humidifiers

9. Dormitory Fee Refund Policy

A. Refund Application Procedure

Yonsei Portal → Log in → Academic Information System → Dormitory

1) Before the official move-in date: Admission Information Inquiry → Cancel Selection → Proceed with refund process

2) After the official move-in date: Apply for mid-term withdrawal → Refund will be processed after verification of the actual check-out date

B. Processing Time

Please note that refund processing may take approximately **three weeks after** the application is submitted.

C. Refund Policy

Category	Period
Full Refund (Cancellation before move-in period)	Applications submitted by August 27 (Thu), 2026 - Refunds will be processed to the bank account registered in Yonsei Portal. - If a student cancels after having a roommate assignment, the assigned roommate will be randomly reassigned to another student, regardless of nationality, department, or student ID number.
Partial Refund (Mid-term withdrawal during residence period)	Applications submitted and actual check-out completed between August 28 (Thu), 2026 – November 26 (Thu), 2026 <u>Refund amount = (Dormitory fee – penalty fee – usage fee for residence period)</u> - Penalty fee = 20% of the dormitory fee (rounded down to the nearest KRW 1) <u>The residence period is calculated from August 28 (Fri), 2026, even if the student did not physically move in.</u> - Residence duration is calculated based on nights stayed. - Students who are subject to forced withdrawal or eviction are not eligible for re-admission within six months. In such cases, the refund will be calculated by deducting the penalty fee (20% of the dormitory fee), and 70% of the remaining amount corresponding to unused days will be refunded.
No Refund	From November 27 (Fri), 2026 onward

10. Additional Information

- The dormitory is not responsible for any loss of parcels or deliveries.
- Smoking, drinking alcohol, and possession of alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited within the dormitory.**
- Unauthorized use of vacant rooms other than the assigned room will result in eviction, and usage fees for the period of unauthorized occupancy will be charged.**
- Using spaces other than the assigned bed and desk number within the assigned room will result in demerit points.**
